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## Canford school sixth form open day

The main points for access to Canford are at 13+ and 16+. There is also the possibility of 14+ enrolment if space is available and if test results and the school report indicate that a pupil can successfully start a two-year GCSE/GCSE programme. The first step is usually to visit the school, but with Covid-19 restrictions currently in place, private family visits are available, but in limited number. Terms and Conditions Entry Breakdown After visiting the school, submitting a completed registration form and fee secures a place on our Admissions List, known as the 'Headmaster's List'. It is advisable to register for Canford as early as possible. About 30 pupils join Canford in the Sixth Form each year from a wide range of backgrounds, both educational and geographic. After visiting the school, the submission of a completed registration form is required by mid-October for access the following September. We will be in touch ahead of time to ask parents of registered children to confirm that they want to take the ISEB test. It's sat at prep schools (or at Canford for those who aren't at a prep school) Those who meet the required standard are invited to Canford for a pre-assessment day in Year 6 of Year 7. It consists of a mix of activities, tests and informal interviews (please see Graphics below for possible pre-assessment entry options). Applicants are invited to the school in early November for tests, interviews and a tour of the school. Applicants from abroad can take these tests at their school. The number of places available through this route will range from year to year, but over the past year about 65% of those who attended Headmaster's List assessments were later offered conditional locations. Places are offered subject to candidates' achieving a minimum of 42 grade points at the best seven GCSEs, including English and Mathematics. Normally, we would expect at least a Grade 7 (or an A grade) to be studied in each subject in the Lower Sixth and at least a 6 (or a B degree) in English and Mathematics. The door is rarely closed, so if you're not offered a place right away, that doesn't mean one won't get available later. The Registrar would like to advise you on the current position at any point. Canford Sports Centre In the Sixth Form is stepping up our Community Action Program, with Sixth Formers taking the lead on support for a wide range of local, regional and international projects. Last year, 8,888 volunteer hours were given by Sixth Formers, with 219 pupils involved in more than 33 different Community Action Programmes. More than 100 hours spent performing musical concerts in care homes, 150 hours visiting patients at the Lewis Manning Hospice and 225 hours were spent helping at 3 local charity shops. If you develop an enthusiasm for something that we'll encourage you to run with it. Each year, groups of lower Sixth Formers are offered the opportunity to spend part of their summer holidays in one of three Participating projects in Argentina, Ghana or India. Trips are always oversubscribed and there is an application and maintenance process for places.
